Dear Ms. ERPELDING,


My name is Patryk P. RYBIŃSKI and I am in charge of FAD – Fathers Against Discrimination a.s.b.l. "Both Parents for All Children™", a non-profit organization based in Luxembourg with its offices in Strassen.

You may recall my last correspondence from Oct. 29th, 2019 sent to you, a member of Ombuds-Comité fir d'Rechter vum Kand. A letter in which I asked if it was possible to meet, a letter to which I have never received any reply.

Please be informed that over the course of last two years we have received numerous reports and documents regarding your public work, your time at ORK, but most importantly your activities as children's lawyer. I think it will not come to you as a surprise that most of the feedback and documents have been presented to us by fathers.

Considering the above we would like to inform you that we will continue to monitor your activities, your proposals you present before court during custody proceedings and collect evidence associated with your work.





The days when public did not know or talked openly about gender-parental discrimination of fathers and children's rights violations in Luxembourg family courts are over. Hypocrisy will end and it is just a matter of time before the changes will be introduced.

Still, should you be interested I would like to ask if we can organize a meeting between us in order to have a chance to discuss the above. I will adjust my schedule to yours. Thank you in advance for your reply.
